

Privacy Notice

Collection of Personal Information

When you access and browse the NSI Summit website (including when you register to attend by completing the registration form on the website) and when you correspond with us by phone or email, you may give us information about yourself. This information is collected and processed on behalf of NSI by UBM, organiser of the NSI Summit and IFSEC International, and can include your name, postal address, email address, landline and/or mobile telephone number, and information about your employment (including your job title, responsibilities and employer's details) as well as other personal information.

How we use your information

Where personal data such as your name, postal address or e-mail address is obtained, then this information is collected and processed by UBM on behalf of NSI and will be used exclusively in connection with the NSI Summit e.g. to provide relevant information about the event, the services requested or for controlling access to restricted areas. The information collected by UBM is passed on to NSI to enable us to contact you regarding the NSI Summit.

NSI will only pass your personal data to other relevant third party organisations or individuals with your explicit consent or where necessary for the purposes of registration and/or relevant NSI Summit communication, or unless specifically compelled to do so by law or court order, or other legitimate reason. The data collected from you will be processed and managed by UBM operating under direct instruction from NSI. Your data will not be used by UBM for any purpose other than in connection with the NSI Summit unless you give your consent for them to contact you on the registration page.

Contact details of individuals who attend the NSI Summit may be shared with exhibitors and sponsors following the Summit, where consent has been given.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.

Secure Website Areas

If you register to use the password protected areas of the site, this data will be used to help control access to these secure areas.

People who contact us via social media

You can contact NSI via Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn or YouTube by direct message if you wish to enquire about our services or wish to comment on our services. These communications are managed by our Marketing department and will only be shared internally at NSI for the purpose of providing you with the information you have requested.

Your rights

Under the GDPR and DPA, NSI recognises and respects that you have rights as an individual providing personal data:

- You must have given explicit consent for NSI and UBM to process your personal data and may withdraw consent at any time.
- You have the right to know exactly how your personal data will be processed by NSI and UBM. NSI commits to processing your data fairly, lawfully and transparently, details of which are set out in this Privacy Notice. Please refer to UBM's Privacy Notice for information about their data protection policies.
- You have the right to request access to the personal data that NSI and UBM hold about you.

If you wish to make a free **Subject Access Request**, please contact us via the email address given below.

- You have the right to request changes to the data held about you if the data is incorrect or requires additional information.
- You have the right to request erasure of your data or the right to be forgotten completely, where there is no legitimate reason for your data to continue to be processed.
- You have the right to request that processing of your data is restricted so that the data remains stored but is not further processed by NSI and UBM.
- You have the right to request a copy of your data in a portable format.

You may notify NSI or UBM of any request to change how your personal data is processed by telephone, email or post.
